Books will be available for purchase. Purchase not required.

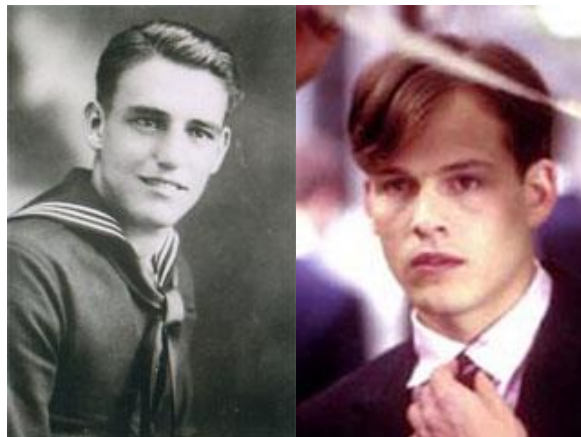
